



## Sound Advice Podcast #10 2 Minute Tips The Pentatonic Major/Minor Switcharoo!

The A minor pentatonic scale works fine for soloing in the A minor key but sounds a little off over the A major key. To play an A major pentatonic instead of A minor pentatonic follow the steps in the diagrams below.

1. Play the Am pentatonic
2. Slide it Down 3 frets (making it F# minor pentatonic)
3. Remove the first F# note
4. Root on the A notes (shown as 'R')
5. You now have an A major pentatonic
